### READINGS

Today we say farewell to Helen, Dan, Isaac and Thea as God calls them to continue their ministry. Our readings concern the call God makes to each of us:

**Isaiah 6:1-8** The prophet cannot understand why he has been chosen by Gd. He is terrified of God's call because he does not feel worthy. Yet all that he will do will be enabled by God who equips him for his ministry.

**Luke 5:1-11** Similarly Simon Peter wants to distant himself from this man of power and holiness, a man who can bring abundance where there has been scarcity. But Christ calls us exactly as we are and accepts our lives, for better and for worse.
