READINGS

Jeremiah 23.23-29

Jeremiah warns against false prophets and unveils their intentions – to make God's people forget God's name. He/God urges careful discernment in our decision making.

Luke 12.49-56

This reading can be read in two halves. In the first half, Jesus tells us how it is. That in following him, there can be no middle way and that people, even those in the closest relationships, will be divided. This thing that He is doing is an enormous, world-changing thing, and they needed to understand that. He follows this, in the second half, with a tirade about discernment. In light of what is to happen, he urges them to wisely and urgently understand for themselves what it is, WHO it is, that is before them and to see the reality of what is going on.
