### READINGS

**Wisdom 1,13-15;2.23-24** Some words of comfort are offered to us here, about God's life-giving intentions for each of us. Death has no place in God's economy.

**Mark 5.21-end** Two stories of desperate people trying to preserve the gift of life that they innately know is theirs for the taking. Will there be enough life-restoring power for both Jairus' daughter AND the haemorrhaging woman? Will the delay caused by the woman have any bearing on Jesus' ability to heal the dying child? Or are we being shown something even more beautiful, amidst all this pain and anguish? An entire community restored to life, perhaps, upon recognising their need for God, submitting to and crying out for the power and purposes of God?
