### READINGS

**THURSDAY WAS ASCENSION DAY:** Ascension day marks our growing up: Christ has no hands on earth now but ours. The task of carrying on Christ's mission may be daunting but — he promises that he will send us his Spirit. The same Spirit that moved over the water of creation bring forth everything out of nothing. Christ's hands are now multiplied across the face of creation ready to usher into being a new creation.

**ACTS 1:1-11** It is comforting that the disciples who lived alongside Jesus and witnessed his death and resurrection still had no clue what his mission, and therefore theirs, was really about: not the recreation of Israel as a political power but the recreation of the whole earth.

**LUKE 24:44-53** Again the risen Christ commands his disciples to wait, again he promises them the same power that he received from God, the creator of all things, again he tells them that God's recreation is intended for all.

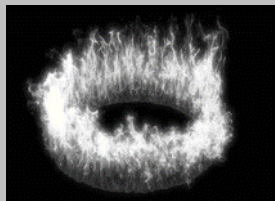

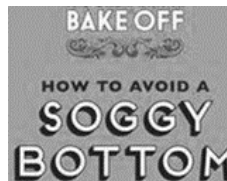
