Readings

2 Samuel 11:26-12:13a King David, not content with all God had given him, takes the wife of another because he sees her and wants her. The prophet Nathan denounces him, for even kings holding great earthly power, are not greater than God. David repents of his sin but even so the outcome of his greed and violence is yet more death. Taking only what is ours leads to life for us and for creation, taking more than our share leads instead to death.

John 6:24-35 Jesus teases the crowd that they are following him just to get more bread following the miracle of the loaves and fishes. The crowd want more miraculous signs in order to believe in Jesus, more miracle bread like the mana in the desert. The crowd have missed the point God's kingdom is not about more and more material prosperity & security, more bread but about having trust in God's good providence that we can give away all that we have, as Jesus did.
