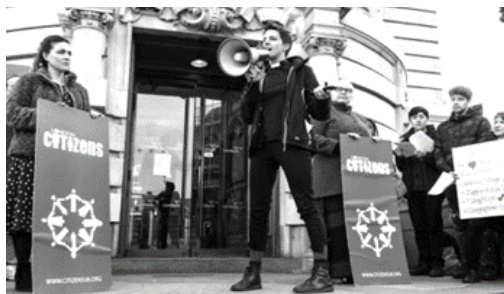

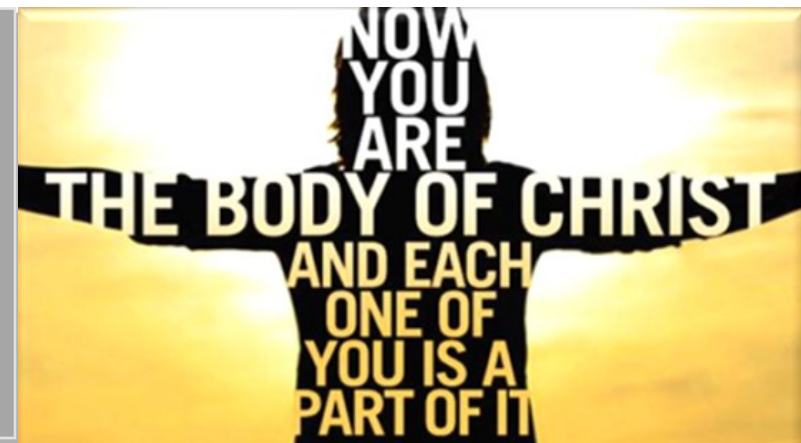

READINGS

Today we have just one reading as we will be baptising twins Diana & Dominic into our family of God.

John 17:20-26

Jesus's last prayer before his crucifixion is a prayer for those he sat with at the table and a prayer for all those who will believe in him. It is a prayer for all of us. Jesus asks that we might know we are loved, that we might know the presence of God with us AND that we might be one. What does it mean to be one? It doesn't mean that we have to all agree with one another or even get on with each other. But it does mean that we are committed to one another and to being a part of what God is up to in a world together, as a community. We are not lone wolves, we are a flock, sometimes stupid and often disobedient, yet always called to be part of something bigger together.
