Readings

2 Samuel 18:5-9, 15 31-33 King David and his son Absalom are engaged in civil war, a war that leads to the death of 20,000 men in battle. David committed to battle against the advice of his counsellors yet asked that in the heat of battle one man, Absalom, should be dealt with gently, because he was the king's son. When Absalom is killed, despite being the king's son, it is he and he alone that David weeps for not the other 20,000.

John 6:35, 41-51 The religious authorities will not accept what Jesus offers because he is the son of no one special, he is just an ordinary person - in terms of the previous reading he was no Absalom but merely one of the 20,000 expendables. He should therefore know his place and stay in it. The inability to see that God offers to all, regardless of parentage, standing or tradition, prevents his hearers from receiving a new identity, a new position, as God's child.
