### READINGS

Genesis 2 In a world in which everything seemed scarce Rebekah appears to see only abundance: chosen to be Isaac's wife; not, maybe, because of her kindness but her spirit and her lack of concern for the rules and conventions that might shackle God's abundant generosity.

Matthew 11: 16-19, 25-end Jesus laments the grown-ups' lack of understanding: children, he tells us, have the truth of God revealed to them more clearly than the supposedly wise and intelligent adults. Conventions and rules and this-is-the-way-it-has-always-been stand in the way of us re-visioning our future through the eyes of God—we need to borrow the eyes of a child to see clearly.
