Exodus chapters 6-14

The story of Moses from the burning bush to the crossing of the Red Sea. Yes! all NINE chapters— don't worry, we'll be hearing an edited version! Our focus this morning is on the 10 plagues and the Passover. The 10 plagues represent 10 opportunities given to Pharaoh to change. We will think about this in the context of Jesus' call for us to show unlimited forgiveness to one another.

In the Exodus story there are winners and losers, God appears to be on one side and not the other. This letter begins with a reminder that Christ's redeeming death was not for one particular group but for the whole world. Our love of Christ shows in our desire to follow his commandment to love one another. No one can say he loves God and hates his brother.

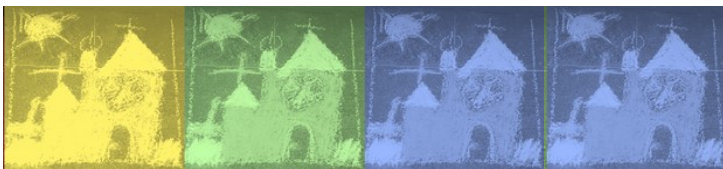
