Readings

Acts 2:1-21

The story of the coming of the Holy Spirit: the gift of the spirit is given to the disciples when they are gathered all together. The spirit is given to all, not just some, and though it is the same spirit, each disciple speaks in a different language. The spirit sends them out and gives them the gift of communication to share the good news of God with whomever they find. Their audience contains representatives of many nations and peoples. Peter reminds his listeners of God's promise to give his spirit to all regardless of age, gender or status.

John 20:19-23

In John's version of the coming of the Holy Spirit the disciples are again gathered together when the risen Christ himself comes to them and breathes his spirit upon them. The breath of Christ reminds us of the breath of God bringing creation into being. The gift of the spirit is an act of re-creation in which we are together remade in the image of Christ.
